WHEREAS, *I Maga'lahi* has declared a holiday closing the executive departments and agencies of the government of Guam on Christmas Eve, Monday, December 24, 2007, in following with the announcement by President Bush closing all Federal executive departments and agencies on that day; and

WHEREAS, the Judiciary of Guam is equally grateful to its dedicated employees who have worked with loyalty and diligence in continuing to maintain a responsive and reliable Judiciary for the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of this spirit of loyalty to the employees and to support the sentiment expressed by *I Maga'lahi* that supports allowing the employees to enjoy the spirit of the season and spend time with families,

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, do ORDER that the Judicial Branch of the government of Guam shall be closed and their employees excused from duty on Monday, December 24, 2007, except that regularly held weekend and holiday hearings will be scheduled per usual practice for weekend and holiday magistrate matters.
